

A ROGUE ADVENTURE

Follow this tour along the Nature's Way.

Day 1

Make an early start this morning and head out to Crocodylus Park for the 10:30 feeding. Then, enjoy lunch in the midst of the crocodiles with a cold drink and a pie from the kiosk before heading to the Adelaide River for a jumping crocodile cruise. Be sure to keep your arms and legs inside the boat! Head east on the Arnhem Highway, stopping at the Mary River Crossing for some crocodile spotting on your way to the Bark Hut Inn for dinner. The Mary River is the most crocodile-dense river in the NT, so you have a good chance of spotting them. Spend the night at Aurora Kakadu on the South Alligator River.

Day 2

Head off early and spend the morning taking in the magnificent views from Ubirr and learning the Bininj Aboriginal people's story of the crocodile through the art on the rock wall. Enjoy a picnic lunch at Cahill's Crossing on the East Alligator River and view crocodiles from the lookout. Take the afternoon Guluyambi Cruise, where your Aboriginal guide will talk about the local flora, fauna and, of course, resident crocodiles. Drive to Jabiru for a night's stay in the famous crocodile-shaped hotel.

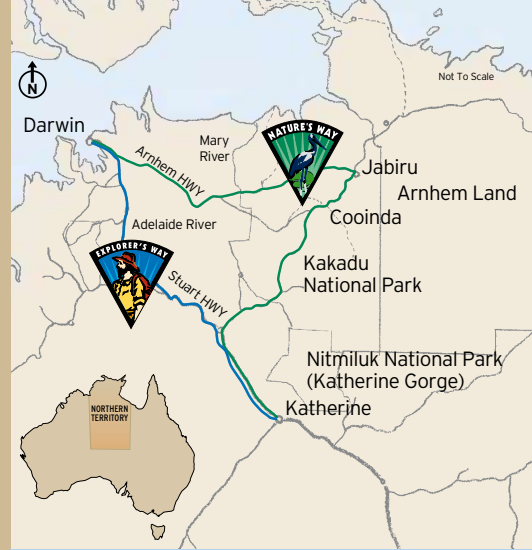
Day 3

Spend the morning enjoying the world-class Bowali Visitor Centre and learning all about local wildlife. Dig in to a delicious lunch at the Anmak An-me Café before driving to Cooina and your chance to spot saltwater crocodiles and birdlife on a cruise around Yellow Water billabong. Later, visit the nearby Warradjan Cultural Centre to learn more about this ancient region and its Aboriginal culture. This evening can be spent searching the Djarradjin Billabong for crocodiles by spotlight on Kakadu Culture Camp's Night Wildlife Tour and learning how the Bininj Aboriginal people manage crocodiles in the Park. Set up camp for yourself or enjoy a safari tent at the Kakadu Culture Camp site.



Day 4

Depart Kakadu National Park travelling south on the Explorer's Way to Katherine. Stop at Nitmiluk Restaurant for a scrumptious lunch overlooking the Katherine Gorge before your cruise down the river. The qualified guides will point out freshwater crocodiles, fish, birds and other wildlife abundant in this region. After a rest, head to Springvale Homestead for the Crocodile Night Adventure where you will find yourself surrounded by the red eyes of freshwater crocodiles, the hoot of owls and the swoosh of jumping wallabies before enjoying a barbecue dinner around the campfire. Retire for the night at the historic Springvale Homestead.



Day 5

After waking up to the sounds of nature at your campsite, start your return journey north. Stop at the Adelaide River Pub to have lunch with some local movie stars. Meet Jock the Croc, the five metre saltwater crocodile from McArthur River and his friend Charlie the Buffalo, who starred in *Crocodyile Dundee*. On your way back to Darwin, stop at the Darwin Crocodile Farm to watch the early afternoon feeding. Meet Burt the crocodile star of *Crocodyile Dundee* and learn all about crocodile acting. Wrap up your tour with a Croc Burger before heading back to Darwin.
